DfE FUNDED TRAINING IN MATHEMATICS FOR TEACHERS WITH QTS

This is an opportunity for those who have a teaching qualification but are not currently teaching a subject in which there is a national shortage. The certificate that is awarded at the end of the year by The National Forest Teaching School, in conjunction with the DfE, will state that you have completed a programme which will enable you to teach Mathematics to GCSE. There will also be the opportunity for participants to gain 30 Masters level credits towards the Masters in Teaching and Learning through Birmingham City University, although completing this element is not a condition of gaining the certificate.

The programme will be delivered through a series of twilight sessions. The course start date is Thursday 25th October 2018.
